





Inaugural Sale Planned for Grayleen and Kivlean Studs

Grayleen and Kivlean Studs are excited to announce they have joined forces to prepare polled R2 bulls for sale in 2025. Since September 27th the bulls are being run together to measure performance under identical conditions.

Both studs have been strict on docility with ease of handling being an essential requirement and true to form, the bulls have settled together extremely well.

It is important for both studs to have our bulls sire commercial animals than can finish before their second winter. Early growth rates and feed efficiency are crucial to this end. The first weigh day showed tremendous growth rates with three bulls already over 600kg and an average of 555 kg at around 15 months.

This performance is no surprise with solid genetics with Ondit, Romn Justice, Meriden Heavy Duty and Wulf's Amazing Bull prominent in the pedigrees.

Ten bulls are being prepared for auction to be held on farm on May 24th at Grayleen Stud in Patumahoe, near Pukekohe. Visitors are most welcome to see what over 50 years of breeding Limousin cattle can deliver. Contact Grayleen 021 992 558 or Kivlean 028 2581 4890.



Presidents Report

He regularly turned up to the NILB Bull Trial, showing an interest in all of the bulls and the trial process. My condolenscences are extended to Steven and his wider family. His legacy is Steven and his enthusiasm for Limousins.

The requirement to revisit our Constitution is a time for reflection on the Society as a whole. The focus of our meeting tonight is our future Constitution and as you can see it needs to be a lot more comprehensive than what we have had in the past. Some of the new legal requirements are items which we have certainly never used in the past.

The main purpose of the Society is to promote the Limousin Breed. It still provides a link between Limousin breeders and enthusiasts but with so few active members, the work load falls on just a few members. At the end of last year I was confident we would have a Bull Trial reinstated yet, despite a structure provided for the Trial, there just was not the member support. Grayleen and Kivlean have combined to run a "Trial" and bull sale. We have 10 bulls which we are happy to offer for sale at this stage, watch this space for the final date at the end of May or early June.

Congratulations to Snake Gully, Natalie and David Roberts for a very successful 30 years of Limousin Sales. The 30th Sale produced impressive prices and a full clearance. It is a successful brand, as Snake Gully has developed a diversity of breeding over the years and modified the sale format over the 30 years. They clearly are the leading R 2 Bull Sale in NZ.
